Footnotes

HILLBILLY TRICK showed speed along the rail, dropped back a bit on the turn, swung out entering the stretch, closed outside the leader the final sixteenth of a mile and was up in time. I'M WITH CONAN rushed up four wide to take the lead entering the turn, opened up in midstretch and tired late. TARBREW , fractious in the starting gate, was very wide on the turn and passed tired horses. BLUE AND GREY saved ground and failed to be a serious menace to the top two finishers. K T'S GOLDEN YEAR , fractious in the starting gate, was three deep on the turn and faltered in upper stretch. MORE GLITTER raced inside horses and was outrun. JIMMY'S REPETE chased the pace and faltered early. RED ROSTER , three wide on the turn, was outrun. ORAPAX showed speed and faltered in upper stretch. Due to timer malfunction, the finish time was hand timed.
