Footnotes

COTURNIX lacked speed, was put to urging approaching the three eighths pole, turned for home three wide, took the lead in midstretch then drove clear. WOLVERTON saved ground stalking the pace, eased out to the two path for the drive, bid for the lead between horses in midstretch then faded in the drive. BABY TIME , along the rail down the backstretch, eased out three wide for the drive and passed tired foes. VIOLA GEORGE sped to the front on the first turn, opened up on the backstretch, set the pace along the rail and tired in midstretch. SHALL WE GATHER raced well off the rail and was not a factor. SILVER EAGLE was outrun. WILD CAPTAIN BOB , steadied when attempting to get out on the first turn, dropped back.
