ROBYNS ANTHEM settled off the rail, moved up three wide into the far turn, was hard ridden leaving the three eighths pole, closed determinedly five to six wide and wore down FOUR KARATS in the final thirty yards. FOUR KARATS stalked the pace, moved to challenge near the three eighths pole, opened up a clear lead after six furlongs, drifted out in the drive, finished gamely and just could not fend off the winner. MACHACHA , three wide early, steadily advanced nearing the lane, lodged a bid between rivals in mid stretch, loomed boldly and flattened out. RIVER KWAI , unhurried early, raced between rivals into the far turn and had some belated action. CUT FOR LUCK broke awkwardly but quickly recovered to sprint clear, set the pace towards the inside, was collared leaving the far turn, held well to mid stretch then faded. MISWES lost ground and failed to respond. FERGIE'S FOLLY saved ground into the far turn and came up empty.
