Footnotes

CHESTERMITE stalked the pace three wide around the first turn, inched closer down the backstretch, prompted three wide around the far turn, dropped back a bit while drifting six wide approaching the lane, slowly gained through midstretch, took a slim lead near the sixteenth pole, dueled inside of POLISH DYNAMITE to the wire and just lasted for the dead heat. POLISH DYNAMITE settled well off the pace while saving ground early, raced three wide around the far turn, came five wide into the lane, closed outside, dueled outside of CHESTERMITE through the final seventy yards and got up on the wire for a share of the dead heat. SAINT OMEGA set the pace along the rail, took heavy pressure around the far turn, drew clear near the three-sixteenths pole, led past the eighth pole but was no match for the top two late. KID CAROUSEL hopped at the start, quickly angled in and rushed up along the rail approaching the first turn, advanced two wide around that bend, pressed the pace two wide down the backstretch, reached near even terms near the half-mile pole, dueled outside of SAINT OMEGA to upper stretch then faded. DUNNELL LANE was unhurried inside around the first turn, advanced inside down the backstretch then dropped back around the far turn. DONT PASS EM was outrun while racing two and three wide.
