Footnotes

JOHN MAPLES stalked the pace off the rail, angled out five wide advancing into the stretch, altered out wider approaching the furlong marker, gained command between rivals near the sixteenth pole and dug in under a drive. SHINE BOX , off slow after an awkward break, moved wide to contention near the five eighths pole, steadied off the heels of the winner nearing the eighth pole, shifted out and finished gamely. JUST HOLLER prompted the pace two wide, moved to even terms into the far turn, dueled between rivals into the lane, battled past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. GREAT BRITAIN , in range saving ground, moved boldly between foes in mid stretch, vied but could not sustain. UNCLE HARRY , in hand three wide tracking the pace, moved to challenge three furlongs out, dueled to mid stretch then faded. MASTER DAN moved clear early, set the pace inside, was joined after a half, dueled inside foes to mid stretch then weakened. The trainer and rider of SHINE BOX claimed foul against the winner for alleged interference in upper stretch. After a review, the stewards found no reason for disqualification.
