Footnotes

VESTIDO bobbed at the break, stalked the pace under rating, moved three wide to challenge into the lane, moved to a clear lead a sixteenth out, drifted out late and held sway under a drive. GROOVIN POINT saved ground advancing mid turn, swung out five wide entering the lane, made a bold run to loom a strong factor departing the eighth pole, continued willingly but just wasn't good enough. FORT BROOK FIELDS tracked towards the inside, steadied near the quarter pole, lacked room making a run in upper stretch, altered out but lacked the needed finish. INDIAN SUGAR , four to five wide, lacked a bid. ISLAND MEMORIES sprinted clear, set the pace inside, was joined into the lane, dueled then weakened. HERD A TURTLES chased and weakened. CAYENNE LADY was not a factor. PRINCESS SUCREE , off slowly, lagged early inside, angled out, was put to the whip nearing the lane but failed to generate a solid run. HOLIDAY DREAMING , urged along giving chase between rivals early, weakened.
