Footnotes

TEQUILA RULES sprinted clear, dictated the pace two wide, opened up under strong handling in mid stretch and proved much the best. VESTRY saved ground chasing the pace and held the place. LET'S DRINK ON IT, three wide into the lane, angled out a bit wider and rallied mildly. HEMISPHERE made a mild run between foes nearing the lane then flattened out. SNOWBALL FIGHT bore out at the break, straightened soon after and advanced four wide into the turn, chased five wide into the stretch and weakened. SUNNY SPARK broke a step slow, rushed up between rivals, chased two wide around the turn and gave way. MONACACY WARRIOR, sluggish early, raced very wide in the drive. KNOCK TWO TIMES saved ground and weakened.
