Footnotes

CLONMEEN LASS , bumped by SARAH'S FANCY when that one was forced in leaving the starting gate, sped to the lead along the rail leaving the first turn, opened up on the backstretch and was kept under urging through the stretch. MISS NUNN FINER stalked the pace, advanced three deep on the far turn, rallied and drifted in near the sixteenth pole. ICE NEEDLE bore in on foes leaving the starting gate, lacked speed, hugged the rail in the stretch and rallied through a narrow gap. KARLUK WAY , pinched back leaving the starting gate, saved ground and failed to rally. SARAH'S FANCY , bumped and forced in by ICE NEEDLE leaving the starting gate, was two wide on the far turn and weakened. NEWYORK QUEEN ROCK , steadied in close quarters along the rail soon after the break, was outrun. QUICK ATTACK , fractious in the starting gate, stopped.
