Footnotes

OUR DUET stalked the pace four wide through the opening half, bid four wide around the far turn, took the lead leaving the five-sixteenths pole, drew off under a drive in upper stretch and held clear under mild urging through the final sixteenth. ROAR OF THE SURGE settled off the pace along the rail around the first turn, moved up inside down the backstretch, advanced along the rail around the far turn, angled out in upper stretch and rallied for the place. FIREFIGHTER set the pace along the rail, vied inside the winner from the five-sixteenths pole to upper stretch then weakened. ARGENT ET ROMEO disputed the early pace while racing between rivals in the two path, settled back down the backstretch, continued to drop back around the far turn then lacked the needed stretch rally. MR. NATIVE pressed the pace three wide and tired in the lane. ALDANITYKAHA raced six wide around the first turn and faltered. SARATOGA GEM never factored while racing three wide and was eased in the lane.
