Footnotes

MR. WINTHROP stalked the pace two wide, took command near the three-eighths pole and drew off under a drive. MR. MANNIE set the pace along the rail, was collared by the winner near the three-eighths pole and just lasted for the place. PASCO GETTLE tracked the pace three and four wide around the turn, drifted out under left handed urging in the lane and finished evenly. AFTERNOON JAZZ was unhurried in the two path, angled out in upper stretch and made a mild rally. TAKE IT ON HOME lacked speed toward the inside, came three wide into the lane and rallied belatedly. PASTERO bore out at the start, raced three wide around the turn, swung six wide nearing the lane and improved his position. SOUTHERN SQUIRE was rank at the start, advanced between rivals nearing the turn and came up empty in the drive. INDIAN RODEO stalked the pace two wide and faded while continuing on his left lead in the stretch. SHORT DANCER failed to menace while racing four and five wide. BROWN AND DALLETT raced three wide between foes and tired. CARSON CITY DUDE steadied along the rail near the seven sixteenths pole and dropped back.
