GROOVIN POINT stalked the pace from the rail, tipped out in upper stretch, took the lead leaving the eighth pole, quickly drew clear and held sway under a drive. SMOOTH JAZIRA angled in nearing the turn, was unhurried inside around the turn, angled out in upper stretch, checked when in tight in midstretch, angled in leaving the eighth pole and closed with a rush. BONBON VIOLETTE disputed the pace two wide, drew clear in upper stretch, held clear past the eighth pole and weakened late. ALLEZ'S CAT hesitated at the start, advanced inside into the turn, swung seven wide nearing the lane and finished well. SUGAR MAY prompted the pace four wide and weakened in the stretch. VIVA BEASLEY was bumped just after the start, raced four wide and rallied belatedly. TINY TUNE LILY disputed the pace from the rail and tired in the drive. UNDER SERVED prompted the pace three wide and came up empty in the drive. LOOKIN FOR ANSWERS failed to menace while racing three wide. HAVANAFANTASY saved ground and never factored. WHY DON'T WE raced two wide around the turn, lacked the needed rally and was steadied in midstretch. ROLLICKING RUBY was bumped just after the start, raced four wide and faded. SERVI ENERGIA was unruly behind the starting gate then trailed inside.
