Footnotes

OCEAN NOMAD, taken to rate while saving ground, moved closer leaving the far turn, angled out approaching the quarter pole, surged past the dueling leaders in mid stretch, responded to right handed pressure and drew away. ACROSS saved ground, advanced into the far turn, stalked the leaders into the lane, shifted out in mid stretch, rallied between rivals and earned the place. STORM HARBOR settled off the rail, gained five wide nearing the quarter pole then was outfinished for the place. LEGAL CODE rated in good position, moved three wide to challenge nearing the lane, duelled to mid stretch and weakened late. SALMOND, two to three wide, advanced some mid way on the final turn then faded in the drive. BIG BOPER set the pace inside, took pressure nearing the quarter pole, battled to the furlong marker then weakened in the final sixteenth. MOON IN, never far back, steadied between rivals leaving the five sixteenths pole then weakened. BING GO ADAMS lacked speed, saved ground nearing the lane then failed to respond. BUD BOYLE settled well back, raced off the rail in upper stretch then had belated interest between rivals. JOSHUA G. failed to menace. NEW PORTWEST pressed the pace two wide and faltered.
