**Footnotes**

CAP'N RAYMOND stalked the pace racing off the rail, swung to the four path in upper stretch, swept to command near the sixteenth pole then drove clear. AVARICE saved ground on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch, drifted in in midstretch, was straightened and rallied outside. ECLAIR DU MONT , in the three path on the turn, chased the pace, gained a short lead in midstretch then weakened late. RAHY'S PLACE , two wide on the turn, chased the pace, gained a short lead in upper stretch then weakened inside the eighth pole. OLD TROUBADOR , checked to avoid the fallen rider entering the turn, swung wide on the bend and rallied. PACMANGO , a forward factor inside horses leaving the backstretch, came out after being steadied in close quarters near the three and a half furlongs pole then failed to rally. TRAIL OF SMOKE set the pace along the rail and weakened in upper stretch. LET'S CALL A TRUCE broke sluggishly then checked and was forced out in the spill entering the turn. ST. AVERIL'S FIRE was outrun after breaking slowly. FOCUS POINT was checked and forced out in the spill entering the turn. VANNA GO'S POINT stumbled and unseated his rider after clipping heels with PACMANGO when that one came out in front of him entering the turn. Following a stewards' inquiry, PACMANGO was disqualified and placed tenth for interfering VANNA GO'S POINT entering the turn.
