Footnotes

WELL LA DEE DAH bobbled early, rated off the duel along the rail through the opening five furlongs, swung four wide to advance nearing the five-sixteenths pole, took command leaving that marker, dueled outside of COOKIE FACE to midstretch, drew clear nearing the sixteenth pole then lasted under a drive. GERALDEE was a bit rank early, raced three wide into the first turn, advanced along the rail leaving the half-mile pole, eased three wide to advance between horses near the five-sixteenths pole, split horses in upper stretch and finished well. WORTHY INTENTIONS dueled along the rail around the first turn, settled off the pace near the five-eighths pole, stalked the leaders three wide around the far turn then finished evenly in the lane. GROOVIN POINT lacked speed in the two path early, advanced three and four wide around the far turn, swung seven wide leaving the five-sixteenths marker, loomed in upper stretch and flattened out in the final sixteenth. PEACE PROPOSAL raced in the two path early, swung five wide near the five-sixteenths pole and lacked the needed rally. COOKIE FACE dueled in the two path between rivals around the first turn, settled off the lead leaving the five-eighths pole, bid two wide around the far turn, dueled inside the winner to midstretch and tired late. CREAMERO disputed the pace three wide around the first turn, drew clear leaving the five-eighths pole, set the pace four wide into the far turn, stopped midway around that bend and was eased late.
