CUT FOR LUCK settled off the duel while racing two and three wide around the turn, swung four wide turning for home, swept to command inside the eight and drove clear. BAREFOOT BABE dueled along the rail around the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch, held clear past the eighth pole but could not resist the winner. TOCCOA rated back along the rail, angled out in upper stretch and rallied belatedly. WAY TO EDEN disputed the pace three wide around the turn and faded in the drive. NENA BELLA raced in the two path around the turn, angled out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. MISS LUCY MAE dueled in the two path between rivals around the turn and tired in the stretch. MOTHERS EYES was outrun while racing three and four wide.
