DESERT STONE broke a bit flat footed, recovered and angled out early to stalk the pace, moved four wide to a short lead past the three eighths pole, drifted out under constant left handed pressure and edged away. DUBAI BEAUTY dueled inside, drifted out through the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. BOWMAN'S BOY chased the pace and came up empty inside. ARNIE'S HONOR broke outward, rushed up to a short early lead, dueled around the turn and gave way. PARKER'S LOVE failed to keep pace. WOODFORD ROAD broke slowly, raced four wide leaving the far turn and was outrun. PEACE DERESISTANCE was forced out at the break. CLASS MOON dropped back.
