Footnotes

SILENT TALE rated forwardly while saving ground near the three eighths pole, angled out and rallied four wide to collar GINPLAY near sixteenth marker then drew away under a drive. GINPLAY prompted the pace two to three wide, took over in mid stretch, continued willingly but proved no match. BLACK RIVER sprinted clear, set the pace towards the inside, was overtaken near the eighth pole and faded. BEGGINFORGIVENESS , four wide chasing the pace, came up empty. NEGRO PRIMERO chased three wide to the top of the lane then weakened. MARQ YOUR BIBLE broke inward bothering rivals, saved ground and failed to respond. BIG DUTCH , bumped and forced in at the break, lagged well back around the turn, swung out wide past the three sixteenths marker and had late interest. SECOND JON , roughed up at the break, was outrun.
