BIMINI STORM , three wide the first turn, moved up outside CLASS CAP on the backstretch, pressed that one until asserting himself in midstretch then readily drew off while kept to his business. PINE MOUNTAIN saved ground, angled to the two path in midstretch and rallied between horses. TREASURE FALLS lacked speed, swung to the seven path in upper stretch and rallied. DASITUATION chased the pace near the rail and gave way. CLASS CAP saved ground setting the pace and weakened late. FARMA WAY JOHN saved ground, angled out in midstretch and was no threat. EPITAPH , bumped soon after the break, was outrun. KINCAID broke slowly, was wide on both turns, advanced to upper stretch then failed to sustain his bid. BLOWOUT WEEKEND , forwardly placed on the backstretch, gave way. ME NO EVIL was outrun. DUMPLING KING was outrun.
