MOVING WEST , unhurried to the far turn, entered the stretch two wide, swung to the four path approaching the eighth pole, closed determinedly under brisk urging and was up in time. PICK FOUR stalked the pace, moved up three wide around the far turn, gained the lead inside the eighth pole, drifted out late and gave way grudgingly. MR. STARR'S REPORT stalked the pace, advanced in the two path between horses on the far turn, gained a short lead in upper stretch and finished willingly. BATON ON FIRE sped to the front, set the pace along the rail and weakened in midstretch. UNAPPROACHABLE raced well off the rail and was no factor. EARLY STAR , wide entering the far turn, was outrun.
