GAS TANK quickly cleared away, set the pace towards the inside, responded when roused right handed in upper stretch and eagerly pulled away while being kept to solid hand urging the final sixteenth. TUBAL stalked the pace, eased out three wide nearing the lane and stayed gamely while holding the place. SKI POLE , three wide in range, swung five wide in upper stretch and finished up well. COBBLER'S MARK , three wide, checked off heels when attempting to advance nearing the stretch, recovered to move between in mid stretch and kept on willingly. GLICH rated in range, steadied mid turn, steadied again nearing the lane, angled out and came up empty. PAGE MCKENNEY , forced inward at the break and was away a beat slow, recovered to move up along the rail, steadied when making his way into the stretch then finished with interest the final furlong. GENTLE AS A BREEZE , between rivals nearing the half mile pole, failed to menace. LUBICK LUCK , four wide, was not a factor. CHECKERED CAB chased three wide to the head of the lane then faltered.
