Q'S JACK hugged the rail in a stalking position, had ample room inside horses through the stretch, swept to command near the sixteenth pole then drew off. TAKE HEED circled horses on the turn, swung very wide in upper stretch then passed tired rivals. HANNIBAL BARCA drifted out leaving the starting gate, set the pace slightly off the rail, was two deep turning for home and gave way late. CAP'N RAYMOND , two deep on the turn, was steadied in tight quarters approaching the eighth pole, swung outside and rallied. BLACK RIVER disputed the pace outside HANNIBAL BARCA and gave way in midstretch. BOCONO , wide on the turn, lugged in near the eighth pole and gave way. B J'S GIBSON was outrun after being steadied in close quarters leaving the starting gate. MY KNIGHT SPECIAL , steadied in close quarters leaving the starting gate, was outrun.
