MISTY LIGHT AIR lacked speed, eased out three wide in upper stretch and rallied mildly. CITI STATE set the pace along the rail and weakened the final sixteenth of a mile. NEGATIVETTE saved ground stalking the pace and gave way. MAE AND REE dropped back.
