Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$75,000 at one mile or over allowed 3 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over, 5 lbs.; \$30,000 at one mile or over, 7 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Closed June 1, 2004, with 48 nominations. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

Footnotes

ART FAN was well handled setting a slow pressured pace towards the inside, disposed of VOUS when roused in upper stretch then held GALLOPING GAL safe while under a drive. GALLOPING GAL was sent up along the inside into the first turn to gain a stalking position, raced off the rail down the backstretch, angled in leaving the far turn, was put to urging nearing the quarter pole, angled out in mid stretch and closed willingly. VOUS prompted the pace outside of the winner and faded in the drive. MINGE COVE , forwardly placed three wide, gained some ground nearing the quarter pole then had nothing left for the stretch drive. LE GRAND BELLE settled towards the inside, swung wide for the drive and faded. ADVENTURE , unhurried early, angled well wide entering the lane and came up empty.
