

## COLONIAL DOWNS - July 10, 2004 - Race 9

STAKES Virginia Derby Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

OUTER TURF FOR THREE YEAR OLDS. Early closing June 1, 2004 at a fee of \$150. Late nominations close Monday, June 28, 2004 at a fee of \$500. \$2425 to pass the entry box. \$2425 additional to start with \$500,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight 122 lbs. Non-winners of two races of \$75,000 at one mile or over since April 1, 2004 allowed 3 lbs.; of such a race since then, 5 lbs.; of a race of \$50,000 at a mile or over in 2004, 7 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations Closed June 1, 2004, with 61 nominations. Trophy presented to the winning owner, trainer, and jockey.

### Footnotes

KITTEN'S JOY was taken to rate early while saving ground, angled out leaving the far turn, advanced four wide to even terms entering the lane, gained a short advantage leaving the three sixteenths marker, drifted out late and edged away under a drive. ARTIE SCHILLER settled well off the rail, quickly gained three wide to take a short lead into the lane, dueled briefly inside of the winner and continued gamely to the wire. PRINCE ARCH encountered some traffic entering the first turn, was taken to rate off the rail down the backstretch, came four wide for the drive and finished with interest though no threat to the top two. LIPAN, three wide early, failed to menace. CLASS CONCERN saved ground chasing the pace and gave way. JANE'S LUCK opened up when a bit difficult to settle, set a brisk pace along the inside for a mile then faltered three sixteenths from the wire. IRISH LADDIE, checked when in tight between rivals near the three furlong marker, failed to recover. NO PLACE LIKE IT lost ground five wide and dropped back.
