Footnotes

O'GULCH rated kindly along the rail, advanced inside around the far turn, got through inside of LOUANN'S BOOT in upper stretch, drew clear nearing the eighth pole and held safe under a steady drive. GOLD PAGEANTRY raced two and three wide around the first turn, advanced four wide down the backstretch, dropped back a bit while still three and four wide around the far turn, came five into the lane, could not match strides with the winner in upper stretch, found his best stride nearing the sixteenth pole and was gaining on the winner through the final sixteenth. LOUANN'S BOOT set the pace in the two path to upper stretch, drifted three wide turning for home, raced between rivals in upper stretch and held well for the show. HUMMING ALONG stalked the pace two wide around the first turn, moved up three wide to press LOUANN'S BOOT down the backstretch and around the far turn then weakened in the lane.
