CLASS BOPPER cleared early, dictated the issue while jumping well, responded nearing the last and eagerly pulled away while kept to a drive. DR. BLOOMER , within range, moved closer inside foes nearing the fifth hurdle, chased the winner and continued willingly to be second best. DARK EQUATION , between rivals early, earned the show. DIVINE FORTUNE , hung out four wide most of the way, came up empty. RIDDLE stalked the pace two to three wide and weakened in the drive. CHESS BOARD (GB) , inside foes early, stalked the pace to the head of the lane and faltered. ORISON , three wide between rivals early, faltered. JAZZ DANCE (IRE) bobbled after the first hurdle, appeared to briefly lose action after the sixth hurdle and faltered.
