AERO stalked the pace around the final turn, had room inside horses after the final hurdle, took command in deep stretch then drew off under brisk urging. MESHWAAR advanced outside horses down the backstretch the final time, dueled the final three furlongs and finished gamely. CLASS CRASH, unhurried early, circled horses on the final turn, dueled and weakened late. WESTERN DYNAMO advanced outside horses on the final turn and failed to sustain his bid. CLASS DEPUTY bid for the lead on the final turn and tired in the stretch run. MR. PIKE gave way. GLOBAL GENIUS (IRE) dropped back and left the course. SABER SONG fell after the penultimate hurdle.
