MUSIC OF ARABIA settled off of a contested pace, advanced three wide in hand leaving the far turn, moved clear past the five sixteenths marker, dug in under strong handling and proved best. AMBARONA, unhurried off the duel, quickly gained three wide nearing the quarter pole, loomed boldly outside the winner nearing mid stretch, raced on her left lead and flattened out. CUPA saved ground advancing into the far turn, angled out with three furlongs remaining, chased the leaders into the lane and finished willingly to earn the show. HALEY HILL, four to five wide, had a mild response. ELEVEN SIXTYSEVEN saved ground off the early pace, angled three wide nearing the quarter pole, shifted back in but came up empty. PLAINLY PUT saved ground, angled out leaving the five sixteenths marker but lacked a bid. FAR SOUTH, unruly pre race, broke a step slow, lagged back off the rail and failed to menace. THAT'SNOTFAIRJENNY lacked speed, checked and altered out avoiding the rider of SEEKING THE BREEZE nearing the lane. SHES LIGHTNIN dueled two wide, moved clear into the far turn, was collared leaving the three eighths pole and faltered. COUNTRY COYOTE gained a good position off the dueling leaders, faltered after five and a half furlongs then came in some tightening up SEEKING THE BREEZE approaching the lane.

CASTLE CAT , off the rail, faltered leaving the far turn then was taken very wide avoiding SEEKING THE BREEZE. SEEKING THE BREEZE dueled inside for a half mile, faltered then lost her rider when clipping heels in tight quarters nearing the stretch. Following a stewards' inquiry COUNTRY COYOTE was disqualified from tenth and placed eleventh for causing interference nearing the lane
