Footnotes

WHAT A WILDCAT worked between horses leaving the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch, took command on his left lead in upper stretch, switched to his right lead late and was ridden out. PRINCE ROBEAR saved ground setting the pace and was out finished. WRITETHATDOWN , in the four path in upper stretch, passed tired horses. NATIONAL STANDARD , very wide on the far turn, passed tired foes. REJECTED prompted the pace outside PRINCE ROBEAR and gave way. WINK AND A PROMISE stalked the pace in the two path, drifted very wide entering the stretch and gave way. ACT OF DOMINANCE was not a factor. BABY TIME , three wide the first turn, lost ground four wide the far turn and was no factor. GLENN'S HOPE , three wide the first turn, weakened. CAULITACAT saved ground and gave way. CASH US NOW trailed.
