Footnotes

PRINCE ROBEAR moved up inside foes to take command nearing the five eighths pole, took pressure into the turn, edged clear with three furlongs remaining, met the bid of SECOND JON in mid stretch, dueled, drifted out under left handed pressure and dug in to narrowly prevail. SECOND JON , four wide early, edged closer three wide around the turn, ranged up outside the winner in mid stretch, dueled, was floated out late and just missed in a game effort. INKSTER saved ground, moved to within striking distance after a half mile, angled out giving chase into the lane but lacked the needed response. PACK A PUNCH broke sharply and led through the initial stages, forced the pace three wide into the turn, gave chase two wide around the turn then tired through the final three sixteenths. QUEEN OF LEGENDS , under rating early while well removed from the inside, failed to menace. ATAJO , four wide under a ride past the three eighths pole, had no response and dropped back after six furlongs. SUMMER IN GIZA pulled his way between runners and took command, pressed the winner into the turn then faltered.
