HEY JACK stalked the pace, was fanned four wide by HUMMING ALONG entering the stretch, bid for the lead in upper stretch, dueled and drove clear late. NEW YORK HOLIDAY , two wide mid way on the far turn, angled in entering the stretch, challenged for the lead in upper stretch, dueled inside the winner and was out finished. ONLY BY INVITATION , floated to the five path turning for home, lacked the needed rally. BOW TIE , swung to the five path entering the stretch, passed tired horses. QUATORZE ROYALTY , well off the rail, passed tired rivals. HUMMING ALONG set the pace slightly off the rail, drifted out leaving the far turn and faltered in upper stretch. WANT AD was outrun. BLUE ROCKET saved ground, stalked the pace and faltered.
