LORELEI'S SONG sprinted to the lead soon after the break, set the pace along the rail, increased her advantage and held sway under steady handling. MISS OIL , unhurried around the turn, eased out to the five path entering the stretch and rallied outside horses. FEISTY BROAD , four deep turning for home, rallied between horses. MIDSUMMER'S EVE hugged the rail on the turn, eased out to the two path in upper stretch, advanced between rivals in midstretch then flattened out. MY QUEEN , well off the rail, chased the winner to midstretch then weakened. FASNACLOICH , three deep on the turn, raced between horses in the stretch and came up empty. SHALL WE GATHER , outrun, swung to the six path entering the stretch. KALAHARI QUEEN , along the rail, chased the pace and faltered in upper stretch. TIDEWATER , squeezed back leaving the starting gate, trailed.
