BERT B DON hugged the rail, swung three wide in midstretch, swept to command approaching the sixteenth pole and drove clear. SILENT TALE, pinched back leaving the starting gate, rushed up along the rail down the backstretch, angled to the two path leaving the turn and finished willingly. SILVER TIE AFFAIR lacked speed, saved ground around the turn, eased out for the drive and rallied. BROKEN TANGO lacked speed, was wide leaving the turn and passed tired horses. D' PEPJO disputed the pace two wide and tired. E. J. LITTLE BOY, a forward factor, was two deep on the turn and gave way entering the stretch. EVERYDAY DAVE hugged the rail, disputed the pace and faltered. Due to a timer malfunction, the race was hand timed
