OLD MAN CRUPI set a pressured pace along the rail and drew off under steady handling. CUMULUS NIMBUS lacked speed, swung out in upper stretch and rallied. DOUGIE'S HALO advanced three wide between horses leaving the far turn and weakened in the drive. PERILOUS LAD , four wide, chased the pace and weakened. COZY LANE , wide on the turns, passed tired ones. ADDEMUP , three wide the first turn, raced five wide on the far turn and weakened. MICKEES MECKE , steadied when bearing out leaving the first turn, dueled down the backstretch and gave way in the stretch. KYLE'S BEAR CLAW was no factor. HASTY RED was no factor.
