Footnotes

BABO settled off the rail, advanced three wide leaving the far turn, lodged a bid mid way on the final turn, dueled from the quarter pole, gained a slim lead inside the eighth pole and prevailed in an extended drive. MR. JONES opened up early, set the pace inside, was collared after five and a half furlongs, dueled inside the winner, had his rider stand up a few yards from the finish and just miss in a game effort. ON THE MARGIN lost ground four wide around the first turn, steadily advanced four to five wide leaving the far turn then continued willingly chasing the top pair to the wire. MALA MALA CAT saved ground, gained around the final turn, eased out but lacked the needed finish. DON'TQUESTION IT settled two wide, moved closer around the far turn, lodged a bid between rivals mid way on the turn, dueled to mid stretch then faded. SWEETEST SIN saved ground and finished with interest. HUGGY BEAR, two wide early, angled out four wide for the drive but lacked a solid finish. HIDE AND SNEEK broke a step slow, was steadied along early, moved up between rivals near the half mile marker, chased the leaders into the lane then faded. GENERAL BEACH failed to menace. OSTIN'S MIRACLE lost ground and was not a factor. SENSATIONAL IMAGE faltered.
