Footnotes

WAIKIKI WAVES , unhurried early, circled four wide into the lane, forged clear in mid stretch and proved best under a drive. CARLET , taken to rate inside, angled out when advancing near the five sixteenths marker, finished willingly and gained the place. LIGHT EVENT settled back, saved ground into the lane and rallied. SMART HOKIE broke slowly, was unhurried early while off the rail, raced four wide leaving the half mile marker and found her best late between rivals. COYOTE TRUE ENOUGH sprinted clear early, set the pace inside, drifted out some and gave way grudgingly. BE MINE MARIA , in mid pack down the backstretch, came five wide for the drive and had some late energy. MISS DIGGY BEAR was not a factor. PRINCESS SYDNEY , unruly behind the gate, saved ground into the far turn and failed to respond. ROLLICKING RUBY was used three wide chasing the pace and tired after six furlongs. SOMBER saved ground into the far turn and weakened. HOOFING stalked the pace two wide, was ridden along leaving the three eighths pole then faltered in upper stretch.
