VIRGINIA CAVALIER , unhurried early off of a quick pace, gathered momentum off the rail leaving the three eighths pole, angled five wide into the lane, responded when called upon, surged past the dueling leaders nearing the sixteenth pole and drew clear in handy fashion. CONCORDE EXPRESS drew off early, set the pace towards the rail, was headed entering the lane, dueled inside SKIFF'S HONOR past the eighth pole and battled back gamely to gain the place. DISCREET DUKE , wide, continued on willingly. SKIFF'S HONOR raced in closest pursuit of the pace setter, moved quickly to challenge mid way on the final turn, gained a slim advantage into the lane, dueled then hung between rivals. COMPLETE DYN0 saved ground into the far turn and lacked a bid. FRATELLO settled in the clear while three to four wide, made slight progress nearing the quarter pole then faded. PERSONAL FIGHT was rated back off heels early, saved ground into the far turn and weakened.
