STORMIN DELIGHT saved ground stalking the pace, eased out when set down in upper stretch, closed and drew out under urging. LUCKMAN, unhurried early, advanced two wide between horses on the far turn, swung wide in upper stretch and rallied. SHARMA set the pace along the rail and weakened the final furlong. SUPER PUTZ saved ground and passed tired ones. UNADULTERATED stumbled leaving the starting gate, was fanned very wide leaving the far turn and was not a late threat. PEAKITUP was no factor. CAREFREE HERO stalked the pace three wide and faltered. MECKLENBURG raced along the rail and was outrun. JAG COLONEL was outrun.
