QUIERO GANAR set a pressured pace along the inside, shook clear after a mile then was fully extended to prevail. A MATCH TO DY FOR , never far back, advanced four wide into the far turn, chased and finished willingly between rivals. FOREVER DAYLIGHT , taken to rate behind rivals, swung out wide in the drive and rallied. DANCINGUPASTORM , in mid pack, advanced along the rail nearing the quarter pole, angled out and continued willingly. TEPEE TOT , taken to rate, lacked room behind rivals from the three eighths pole to the quarter pole, split rivals in mid stretch then steadied lacking room in the final yards. IDEAL SCENARIO stalked the pace, raced between rivals around the far turn and faded. MINE FOR KEEPS saved ground, moved up into the far turn, chased the leader into the lane then faded. P S IT'S AMERICAN lost ground throughout. SENECA WIND stalked the pace off the rail and gave way. RETURNED ALL was outrun. CLASS VIGOR , washy, pressed the pace two wide for nearly a mile and faltered in upper stretch.
