SUNSHINE NUMBERS, steadied in traffic midway on the first turn, raced well off the rail, closed determinedly and drew clear. PUBLIC ADDRESS saved ground, eased out leaving the far turn, worked between horses in upper stretch and rallied. STARPOLEON, wide the first turn, opened a clear lead on the far turn and tired in the drive. LIGHTENING LIMIT, wide the far turn, had a mild rally. BROTHER BANKS showed early speed, was rated back on the backstretch, raced between horses in the stretch and weakened late. UPINDEED, wide on the turns, was no factor. GOSSIPMONGER, outrun, raced very wide entering the stretch. GIMME NO LIP raced along the rail and was in narrow quarters in midstretch. EXCLUSIVE FIRM showed speed slightly off the rail and faltered. LIGHTNING FORCE, steadied in tight quarters soon after the break, was outrun. GOODBYE was in close quarters leaving the backstretch. QADAR, checked in traffic leaving the first turn, was no factor.
