AMERICAN CROSSING , patiently rated four and five wide, moved closer after a half mile, forged to command in upper stretch and eagerly drew away under a vigorous hand ride. UNSPEAKABLE saved ground in range, angled out in upper stretch, finished willingly and got the place late. LILLY LEGGS tracked three and four wide, lodged a bid after a half, kicked clear inside the three eighths pole, was taken on in upper stretch and weakened through the final furlong. HERD A TURTLES moved up two wide inside MS DREWCILLA nearing the turn, dueled around the turn then weakened nearing the furlong marker. CHLOE CAROL bore out at the break, raced wide and was not a factor. SMART HOKIE , pinched back at the break, lost any serious chance. MS DREWCILLA cleared early while well off the rail, was joined into the turn, dueled and faltered.
