OUTER TURF FOR TWO-YEAR OLDS. . No nomination fee. \$250 to enter and \$250 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Wednesday, July 13, 2011 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees) \$50,000 Guaranteed. After payment of 1% to all owners of horses finishing 6th through last, 60% of the remaining purse shall be paid to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: 120 lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstake allowed 2 lbs.; of two races other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs; a race other than maiden or claiming on the turf 6 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to fourteen (14) starters.

Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest lifetime earnings. Failure to draw into the race cancels all fees. Trophy to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, July 7th, 2011 with 44 nominations. (Rail at 50 feet).

Footnotes

MAJOR MAGIC , bumped at the break, was taken to rate while off of contested early pace, steadily gained off the inside mid turn, drifted out when angling under left handed urging in upper stretch, was straightened away near the furlong marker, closed determinedly under right handed pressure and forged ahead at the wire. ANCIL vied early inside, eased back off the leader entering the turn and angled out, moved closer near the quarter pole, rallied four wide under right handed urging to take command inside the eighth pole, briefly went clear a sixteenth out, dug in gamely when challenged in deep stretch but just could not hold. CURFEW TOWER broke inward, was straightened and chased the pace, rallied through tight quarters inside OUR HALF in mid stretch, threatened but could not go with the top pair late. OUR HALF drifted in and bumped the winner at the break, hustled up and grabbed command three wide, edged clear of rivals leaving the far turn, set the pace two wide into the stretch, took pressure from the inside in mid stretch then faded late. JONMIL JOHNNY vied early between rivals, was steadied back off the leader when in close entering the turn, regrouped and chased four wide into the stretch then tired in the final three sixteenths. GETUPWITHTHESUN broke outward, chased the pace four wide and tired in upper stretch. VARBOROUGH was steadied after being forced in at the break, raced greenly early while well out in the track and never menaced.
