**Footnotes**

AIR SUPPORT settled back while saving ground, picked up momentum leaving the far turn, followed CASINO HOST when advancing along the inside five sixteenths out, was maneuvered out into the lane, rallied under left handed pressure to gain command between rivals inside the sixteenth marker then dug in gamely under steady handling to turn away BANNED. BANNED bobbled at the break, eased back from between rivals passing the wire the first time, made a solid rail run approaching the lane, swung out five wide in upper stretch, ranged up boldly to threaten the winner in deep stretch but wasn't quite good enough. CASINO HOST saved ground while well within range, moved closer leaving the three eighths pole, angled out continuing his run nearing the stretch, moved to collar STREET GAME in mid stretch, gained a slight advantage soon after, met the challenge of AIR SUPPORT a sixteenth out then gave way grudgingly. NEWSDAD lagged back while two to three wide, waited behind rivals with run nearing the stretch, swung out six wide at the head of the lane and finished up with good energy. STREET GAME set a slow but pressured pace while inside, edged clear around the far turn, moved away a bit three furlongs out, turned back a threat from CALLINGAHARDTEN entering the lane, was joined by CASINO HOST a furlong out, gave some resistance then weakened through the final sixteenth. KING CONGIE was steadied when in close between rivals early on in the run through the first turn, raced removed from the rail past the five eighths pole, dropped to the inside for the run into the stretch but lacked a solid response. CRIMSON CHINA under snug rating early while between rivals, brushed with THE WACO KID after a quarter mile, continued within range between foes down the backstretch, came under a ride leaving the three eighths pole but failed to respond. CALLINGAHARDTEN tracked the pace while inside rivals, angled out when making a menacing move after a mile, chased the leader past the three sixteenths pole then gave way. BENERGY lost ground four to five wide and dropped back after seven furlongs. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET duelled early outside STREET GAME, hounded that one down the backstretch, continued a forward presence chasing the issue to

the quarter pole then tired. THE WACO KID , four wide, brushed with CRIMSON CHINA under the wire the initial time, stalked the leaders to the far turn then dropped back. WATCH ME GO , four wide early, was under a ride a half mile out, dropped back around the final turn and was floated out six wide into the stretch.
