Footnotes

PADDY O'PRADO was unhurried while racing just off the rail through the opening three-quarters, rallied inside entering the far turn, eased out to split horses near the three-eighths pole, angled back to the rail in upper stretch, swept to command near the three-sixteenths pole, quickly drew clear then held clear under a steady drive. INTERACTIF was rated off the pace while racing in the two path around the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn then finished well through the lane. KRYPTON was unhurried while just off the rail through the opening three-quarters, advanced four wide around the far turn then made a mild rally through the lane to gain the show. TWO NOTCH ROAD quickly drew clear while drifting out soon after the start, set the pace off the rail to upper stretch, could not resist the winner nearing the three-sixteenths pole, vied between rivals to midstretch then weakened in the final furlong. STATELY VICTOR was devoid of speed while saving ground early, raced three and four wide around the far turn and passed tiring rivals in the lane. MAJESTICTROUBADOUR was in tight just after the start, moved up the first time through the stretch to prompt the pace three wide around the first turn, continued to chase the pace around the far turn then tired in the drive. AWESOME DREAM chased the pace in the two path for three-quarters and dropped back around the far turn.
