Footnotes

MISTER DISH disputed the pace along the rail down the backstretch, settled back entering the turn, swung three wide leaving the three-eighths pole, bid three wide in upper stretch, dueled outside to midstretch, drifted in near the eighth pole, was bumped by WOHALI soon after, dueled outside of that rival through the final furlong, was bumped again by WOHALI nearing the wire and prevailed under a steady right-handed drive. WOHALI dueled between rivals down the backstretch, dueled inside of CLOSING HOUR around the turn, vied inside of the winner through the lane, drifted out under left-handed urging and bumped the winner in midstretch and again nearing the wire. ROYAL HILL raced along the rail around the turn, swung outside in upper stretch and was along late for the show. CLOSING HOUR dueled outside of WOHALI to upper stretch, vied between horses in upper stretch, dropped back nearing the eighth pole, sharply altered course when MISTER DISH drifted in in midstretch then finished evenly. DUNCAN MCFLY raced three wide between rivals around the turn then lacked the needed rally while drifting out through the lane. JAZZMAN'S DANCE raced four wide and never factored. BREWSTER COUNTY flashed some speed in the two path and faded in the lane. WONG FOO raced two wide around the turn, came four wide into the lane and lacked a rally. The rider of BREWSTER COUNTY claimed foul against the winner, alleging interference near the three-eighths pole, the rider of WOHALI claimed foul against the winner alleging interference near the wire and the rider of CLOSING HOUR claimed foul against the winner alleging interference leaving the eighth pole. The Stewards found no reason for disqualification and allowed the original order of finish to stand.
