OUTER TURF FOR FILLIES THREE YEARS OLD. Early closing May 28, 2008, at a fee of \$100. Late nominations close Monday July 7, 2008, at a fee of \$500. \$950 to pass the entry box. \$950 additional to start with \$200,000 Guaranteed, of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weight: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$75,000 at one mile or over allowed 2 lbs.; \$50,000 at one mile or over, 4 lbs.; \$30,000 at one mile or over, 6 lbs. (Maiden and claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Early nominations closed Wednesday, May 28, 2008. Late nominations closed Monday, July 7, 2008, for a total of 58 nominations. Trophy to the owner of the winner.

I LOST MY CHOO , patiently rated, raced in the two path entering the far turn, eased out four wide when commencing her bid near the quarter pole, closed determinedly under urging and drove clear late. NAMASTE'S WISH saved ground under rating, eased out two wide entering the stretch and rallied gamely. JULIA TUTTLE opened a long lead early, set the pace along the rail and faded late. NIJINSKY BALLETT raced forwardly along the rail and weakened in the drive. ATHENA'S GIFT lacked speed, raced inside horses turning for home, angled out in upper stretch and failed to threaten. CHEROKEE QUEEN , a forward factor three wide, gave way. BORN TO BE , outrun, raced wide in the stretch. CLARA'S SONG was outrun. THREE GRACES raced in the two path and gave way.
