Footnotes

LIL LINDA was unhurried while racing three wide around the first turn, advanced three wide around the far turn, rallied in upper stretch, swept to command near the sixteenth pole and drew off. FANATICAT set the pace along the rail, edged clear nearing the far turn, widened in upper stretch, held clear past the eighth pole, was collared near the sixteenth pole and held well for the place. CARLET was well-placed along the rail through the opening three-quarters, angled out in upper stretch, drifted in in midstretch, shifted back out soon after and rallied late. ELLE TEMPO saved ground, angled out and passed tiring rivals. SMOOCHIE HOOCHIE lacked speed while saving ground through the opening three-quarters, swung six wide nearing the quarter pole and finished with good energy on the far outside. BRAZILIANBOMBSHELL prompted the pace in the two path while between rivals through the opening half, dropped back a bit and angled to the rail nearing the far turn, chased the pace inside around that bend and faded in the lane. D. DON'T DANCE raced three and four wide and never factored. INTITRICKU prompted the pace three wide and tired in the lane.
