Footnotes

OVER THE LEA tracked the pace three wide under rating, moved closer into the far turn, edged clear after six furlongs, opened up under stout left handed pressure in mid stretch then continued to widen under a drive. ADA CLARE, taken to rate early, advanced three wide between rivals into the stretch and stayed gamely to save the place. SHADOW LANE rated close up three wide, came four wide for the drive and continued willingly between rivals. SMART TORI rated forwardly behind dueling rivals, checked when in close nearing the lane, shifted out five wide past the three sixteenths marker and rallied mildly. POPULAR ACT cleared early and angled in to set the early pace, was headed near the five eighths pole, disputed the pace to the three eighths pole then gave way. BACK FOR DINNER, three wide early, moved to a short lead five furlongs out, dueled into the far turn, continued a presence to the head of the lane then gave way. UNSEEN GLORY clipped heels nearing the far turn and lost her rider. The rider of SMART TORI claimed foul against the riders of SHADOW LANE and ADA CLARE for alleged interference entering the stretch but no action was taken. There was also a stewards inquiry into UNSEEN GLORY'S trip into the far turn.
