Footnotes

AFTERNOON JAZZ stalked the pace while racing in the two path between rivals around the turn, came three wide into the lane, made a mild rally in upper stretch while on his left lead, switched leads in midstretch, closed and was up in the final strides. KNIGHT OF SIN pressed the pace from the rail down the backstretch, settled back a bit into the turn, eased two wide near the five-sixteenths pole, vied outside of GENUINE JUSTICE through upper stretch, took the lead in midstretch, inched away from that rival and led to the final strides. ROYAL RICHES stalked the pace three wide around the turn, came four wide into the lane and rallied for the show. ZIP ALONG stalked the pace from the rail around the turn, stayed inside through lane and lacked the needed rally. GENUINE JUSTICE set the pace along the rail, vied inside of KNIGHT OF SIN through upper stretch and weakened in the final furlong. RICHIE THE THIEF stalked the pace three and four wide between rivals around the turn, came five wide into the lane and was out kicked in the stretch. DOWN THE TRACK never threatened while racing two and three wide. LITTLE B P raced in the two path and never factored. MANHATTAN PHIL saved ground around the turn, swung six wide near the quarter pole and was outrun. LITTLE JOE EXPRESS chased the pace four and five wide around the turn and faded in the lane.
