Footnotes

HOUND gained the lead on the first turn, saved ground, turned back a challenger in midstretch and drew out. SHOW US RYAN stalked the pace inside horses, eased outside in upper stretch and rallied. R. B. FLOAT saved ground, advanced along the rail entering the stretch, was steadied when blocked inside the eighth pole, angled out near the sixteenth pole and finished gamely. MAJOR IMPROVEMENT chased the pace, challenged for the lead outside the winner turning for home and weakened late. HAY PRINCE saved ground and weakened. LOUANN'S BOOT, four wide the first turn, moved up outside horses, left the far turn in the three path and faltered in upper stretch. An objection by the rider of R.B. FLOAT against SHOW US RYAN for alleged interference near the eighth pole was not allowed.
